

# Contractor and Supplier Requirements

HSW-MSP-PR11-A1

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## 8.4 Health and Safety

- 8.4.1 SUT has obligations to its employees, contractors and other persons with respect to health and safety in matters over which it has control, including ensuring SUT does not expose contractors or other persons to risks arising from its undertakings.
- 8.4.2 To meet SUT's obligations under applicable health and safety legislation and to ensure a safe workplace, when SUT engages the Service Provider to provide the Services the Service Provider must:
- (i) manage all health and safety risks which may arise as a result of the delivery of the Services;
  - (ii) monitor and supervise the arrangements in 8.4.2 (i), but SUT reserves the right to do so (either in addition to, or in place of the Service Provider) at any time; and
  - (iii) in order to demonstrate due diligence, and to obtain assurance in respect of safety arrangements, complete a pre-qualification questionnaire ("**Prequalification**") when requested by SUT;
- 8.4.3 On request, the Service Provider must provide SUT evidence of:
- (i) the management of health and safety risks by the Service Provider in respect of the Services or when conducting work for which they have been engaged to undertake;
  - (ii) any assurances made during Prequalification;
  - (iii) compliance with any instructions provided to the Service Provider, their workers and subcontractors in respect of safety arrangements implemented by SUT or otherwise required under this Agreement.
- 8.4.4. In performing the Services or when conducting works, the Service Provider must:
- (i) with-out delay and as soon as known to the Service Provider:
    - (A) notify SUT of all incidents, near-misses or hazards which occur or may be present at any SUT premises; and
    - (B) if requested by SUT provide any reasonable assistance including (where relevant) any rectification plan or schedule; and
  - (ii) comply with all reasonable SUT directions including:
    - (i) the immediate but temporary cessation of any works; and
    - (ii) removal of any Service Provider employee, worker, subcontractor and their property from SUT premises which in SUT's reasonable opinion may be a risk to health and safety or breach the Service Provider's OHS Obligations.
