Program	Future Leaders Program is a two-week study tour to China with an exciting opportunity to explore leadership concepts in an international context. Activities will include industry visits, seminars and meetings with government officials.	
Proposed Academic Plan	Students will work in groups to develop an in-country theoretical project, to be presented to Deans in 2010 as graduates.	
Program Costs	Full Package	\$4,000 approximately <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Package will include airfare, accommodation, travel insurance, basic visa fees and ground transport. ▪ Package does not include meals, entry fees and personal spending money.
Deposit Required	\$500 Registration deposit is due by 13 th September. The deposit should be paid to the Swinburne cashier using the Deposit Payment Form (<i>Supplementary Form 2</i>), and a copy of receipt returned to Swinburne Abroad.	
Balance Payments	Payment in full is due by 27 th September and 11 th October in installments, after you have been offered a place into the program. Bookings will not be confirmed until final payment is received. All payments are to be made to the cashier and a receipt of payment returned to Swinburne Abroad.	
Cancellations	Cancellations after 13 th September 2010 could incur a penalty. Cancellations MUST be made in writing to Swinburne Abroad. Cancellations received after 27 th September will forfeit deposit paid and any other non-refundable portions already paid. If program cannot run due to insufficient number of applications, students will receive a full refund.
