

# POST GRADUATE PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTING PROGRAMS

## Semester 2-2009 Course Structure (Saturday part time block mode)

The Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma and Master of Professional Accounting form a nested program. A nested program is a sequence of study which is followed to obtain the highest available award and which has multiple entry and exit points. This structure allows students the flexibility to qualify for the ultimate award or exit at an earlier stage. Students may not receive multiple awards for continuous study in a nested program.
