### COURSE STRUCTURE

The Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma and Master of Accounting form a nested program. A nested program is a sequence of study which is followed to obtain the highest available award and which has multiple entry and exit points. This new structure allows students the flexibility to qualify for the ultimate award or exit at an earlier stage. Students may not receive multiple awards for continuous study in a nested program.

On completion of all 12 above units of study, students exit with a Master of Accounting ( <b>BMAC640</b> ) with the exception of students admitted to the Non Graduate Entry program.

The above 4 units complete the 16 Unit of study programs: Master of Accounting (Honours) **BMAC640H** and Master of Accounting Non Graduate entry **BMAC640N**

The award of Honours will be subject to a student completing 16 units of study (200 credit points) AND attaining a 75% average over the 4 honours level units of study (50 credit points), or a 70% average over the final 8 units by study (100 credit points) Students who complete 200 credit points but do not attain the required performance level to receive the award with Honours may graduate with the Master of Accounting award.

\*Students must apply for alternative electives on a "Postgraduate External Unit Application" form available from AGSE reception. Electives may be selected from any Masters level program offered by FBE subject to approval of relevant Program Directors.
