The MComm (Social Investment & Philanthropy) program requires successful completion of the following units of study. The Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma, Master of Commerce (Social Investment & Philanthropy) form a nested program. A nested program is a sequence of courses which is followed to obtain the highest available award and which has multiple entry and exit points. This structure allows students the flexibility to qualify for the ultimate award or exit at an earlier stage. Students may not receive multiple awards for continuous study in a nested program. **Please note available semesters and pre-requisite units when creating your program plan**
