

Course Structure

The Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma and Master of Management in Strategic Foresight form a nested program. A nested program is a sequence of study which is followed to attain the highest available award and which has multiple entry and exit points. The structure allows students the flexibility to qualify for the ultimate award or exit at an earlier stage. Students may not receive multiple awards for continuous study in a nested program. The MMgt(Strategic Foresight) requires successful completion of 12 units of study inclusive of all eight (8) core units of study plus completing one of the Stage 3 options.
