



Masterclass Agile Project Management

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(L) 2 day (Pace-to-face, Live online, Workplace \$ 2000)

This two-day Masterclass begins by providing a background to Agile methodologies, their philosophy, values, and principles. The key reasons for adopting Agile together with comparative benefits are then discussed. The Scrum framework is used to describe the delivery life-cycle of an Agile project. Agile development teams are then formed and participants apply Scrum to project scenarios.

Participants learn and apply a variety of tools and techniques to develop and refine the product backlog, define user requirements and quality, estimate durations, then manage and review progress towards achieving a version of a complete product. Reviews and retrospectives are practiced to receive feedback, manage risk, and refine the process.

The challenges of implementing Agile in organisations will also be discussed in this masterclass. Participants will be asked to consider both the applicability and readiness of their respective organisations for Agile adoption with the aim of creating a road-map for implementation back into the workplace.

- · Consider the steps required and challenges faced in implementing Agile within an organisation.

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
