### Entry requirements

**English language requirements:** IELTS 6.0 with no individual band below 6.0

**Indian 10+2 results:** 65%, or equivalent Australian ENTER 70

**Prerequisite:** Advanced Maths

### Flight training

If you wish to achieve your Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL), you can undertake flight training throughout the three-year course. Flight training is provided by Oxford Aviation Academy at Moorabbin airport. Oxford Aviation Academy and Swinburne work together as preferred providers of cadet pilot training for Qantas in Melbourne.

You can also undertake additional training to complete a Multi Crew Cooperation course or a Multi Engine Gas Turbine Endorsement.

The Oxford Aviation Academy fleet includes 20 new Cessna 172 and 182 aircraft with advanced glass cockpit technology.

### Additional fees – flight training

In addition to course fees, flight-training fees are payable to Oxford Aviation Academy.

#### Fees for 2010

A\$76,770 includes a CPL(A) with endorsement for Night-time Visual Flight Rating (NVFR), endorsement for aerobatics and single engine command instrument rating.

In addition, students can undertake a Multi Crew Cooperation course (A\$8510) and a Multi Engine Kingair Endorsement (A\$17,600).

Fees are payable in stages linked to training progression.

Additional costs for flying training texts and equipment, Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) licensing and examinations of approximately A\$7563 are payable.

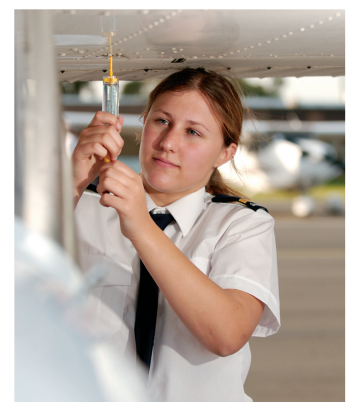
