## What is the International Exchange Program?

The International Exchange Program offers you the opportunity to study at an overseas institution for a semester or a full year. You will receive credit towards your Swinburne degree by studying units approved by your Academics and Faculty Administrator.

## When and where can I undertake an International Exchange?

Swinburne Abroad encourages Faculty of EIS students to undertake exchange in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, or 5<sup>th</sup> semester of 3-year degrees, and additional options of 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> semester of 4-year degrees.

Determining where you can go on International Exchange depends on your discipline of study and the units you require during the intended semester of exchange.

## Are there limited exchange places?

There are limited places at some partner institutions. It is important that you consult your Swinburne Abroad Adviser to determine your eligibility for a particular host university.

## When is the deadline for applications?
