1. 2. 3. Students enrolled in the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD), Doctor of Psychology (Clinical Psychology), or Doctor of Psychology(Counselling Psychology) will be funded by the Faculty to attend a maximum of six (6) full-days (or 12 three hour sessions) at no cost to the student.
