Getting started at TAFE

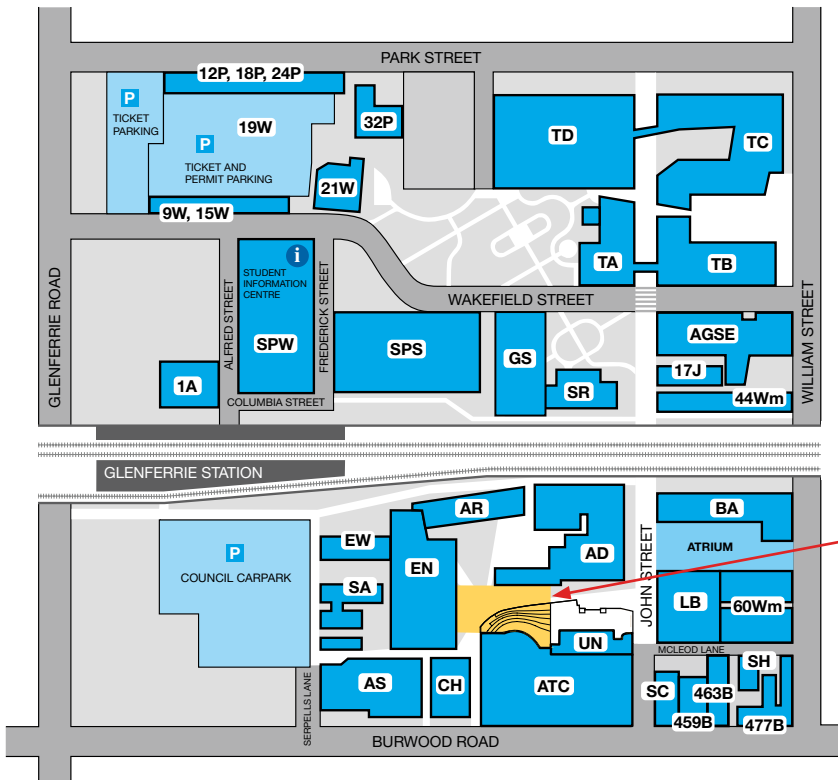
We know you want to enjoy and thrive in the challenges of your course. This session will give you some tips on how to hit the ground running and make a successful start at TAFE.
