The <u>Diploma of Interior Design and Decoration</u> provides students with the skills and knowledge to create plans and undertake projects in interior design and decoration. It teaches students the skills to undertake industry-based design projects in later stages of the course; they learn how to create and plan furniture, fittings, surfaces and colour schemes for commercial and residential settings.

Elective


A structured set of 19 units specific to your Course.

When enrolling online ensure that you select the correct year, 'All Study Periods' and 'All Locations' on the study plan view. See below for an example.




Enrolling into Clusters

Step 1. Expand the cluster by clicking the plus sign in the far left corner of the cluster name
