The [Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care](#) is for those who are interested in working in the early childhood services sector, or who are already working in the field and are responsible for planning, implementing and managing programs in early childhood services. At this level, workers have responsibility for the supervision of staff and volunteers.

Course Structure:

The Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care requires twenty eight (28) units to complete. This course is made up of twenty three (23) core units and five (5) electives.

How to use your Course Planner

- Core Units**
A set of compulsory units you **MUST** complete as part of your Course.
- Elective Units**
A structured set of 5 units specific to your Course.
- Clusters**
A sub-structured set of 2 or more units delivered together specific to your Course.

Step 1 Pre-Enrolment:

To view timetable options for your course select the **'Group Registration'** button on the right side of the screen

Step 2 Select **'View Timetable'** to select your timetable option

Step 3 To select your timetable option and register into classes select **'Choose'** on the right side of the screen

Step 4 Select **'Register in selected Group'**

Step 5 Complete enrolment into units:

Select year, All Study Periods and All Location. See below for an example. You must **enrol in every unit** on your study plan

Enrolling into Clusters:

1. Select the Cluster by ticking the top box on the far right hand side of the Cluster

2. The units will automatically tick and the Cluster and the units will become green

3. Click the Enrol button

4. Click the Confirm Enrolment Button

5. Click the View Enrolment Button

6. Repeat Steps 1-5 for all ten (10) clusters delivered in this course
