

EMPLOYMENT LEVELS




Employment levels of selected occupations in Direct Client Care and Support - 2008 to 2018

JOBS GROWTH

Health care and social assistance industry workforce is expected to grow significantly over the next five years, with forecasts indicating it will reach 1.9 million workers in 2023

DIPLOMA OF NURSING

Three in four (76%) enrolled nurses are aged 35 years of age or over. The average age of an enrolled nurse is 46.0 years (National average is 40 years)

Enrolled nurses administer and monitor medication care for older clients, acute care clients and people with chronic and mental health conditions. You will also develop effective communication skills and learn how to work as a professional within the legal and ethical parameters in nursing.

The Enrolled Nursing provide individuals with a learning and employment pathway into enrolled nursing occupations and Higher Education qualifications.

- 18 month program

- 2 year program

CERTIFICATE III IN INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT (AGEING, HOME & COMMUNITY)

Individual Support workers who wish to work with people living with disability in both residential, community and health care settings.

Workers in this sector assist to enable people with disabilities to be more independent, participate in community and recreational activities whilst ensuring a client-centred approach.

- 6 month program
- 13 units, 7 core and 6 electives
- practical placement 80 hours.





CERTIFICATE III IN INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT (DISABILITY)

Individual Support workers deliver quality care in the aged and home and community sectors. Graduates can expect to work with other health care professionals such as nurses, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, community and disability workers, and work with diverse people to support and provide individualised care

Students learn in a safe, simulated environment before undertaking clinical placement in the field supported by our qualified and dedicated facilitators.

90,000 full-time equivalent (FTE) staff will be needed to assist in the delivery of services through the NDIS

- 6 month program
- 13 units, 7 core and 6 electives
- practical placement 80 hours.



CERTIFICATE IV IN MENTAL HEALTH

Non-clinical mental health workers who:

- Support and assist those in the mental health recovery/psychosocial disability process to achieve their goals.
- Wellbeing and mental health assessment and promotion
- Trauma informed care
- Crises and risk management
- Community-based activities focusing on mental health and group skills

Students enrolled in the Certificate IV in Mental Health may also be eligible to complete the Certificate IV in Mental Health Peer Work - Acknowledging and working with the lived experience of mental health as best-practice

- 6 month program
- 15 units, 11 core and 4 electives
- practical placement 80 hours.

CERTIFICATE IV IN ALLIED HEALTH ASSISTANCE (PHYSIOTHERAPY, OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY)

Assistant to physiotherapists, occupational therapists and/or dieticians in acute, sub-acute, rehabilitation, aged care or community settings.

- 6 month program
- 16 units, 7 core and 9 electives
- practical placement in community health or hospital 120 hours.



CERTIFICATE IV IN ALLIED HEALTH ASSISTANCE - SPORT AND FITNESS

Assistant to physiotherapists, delivering therapeutic programs under supervision primarily in the sport and fitness industry. But also can work in clinical areas such as hospitals, aged care, special development schools or community rehabilitation settings.

- 9 month program delivered in partnership with Richmond Institute of Sports Leadership (subsidiary of Richmond Football Club)
- 2 work placements (1 x physiotherapy community health or hospital setting, 1 x in the fitness industry)

CERTIFICATE III IN NON-EMERGENCY PATIENT TRANSPORT

Provide safe, non-emergency transport and care for patients suffering from an illness or disability.

Deliver first aid, drive non-emergency vehicles, provide appropriate patient assessment and follow procedures.

On completion, you'll be ready to seek employment at organisations such as the Royal Flying Doctors and Ambulance Victoria, or at local hospitals and private companies outsourcing non-emergency patient transport.






NURSING AND HEALTH JOB READINESS AND EMPLOYABILITY EXPO

MY EXPERIENCE AT SWINBURNE


- All my teachers have industry experience and can offer real insights to the work we are doing


