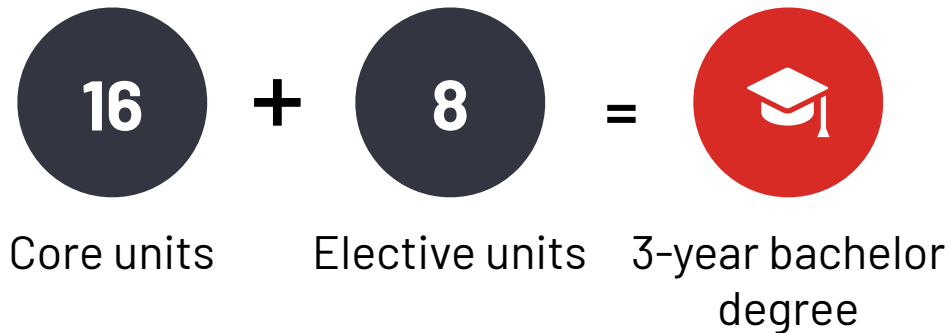
Criminal justice:
