We also respectfully acknowledge Swinburne's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander staff, students, alumni, partners and visitors.

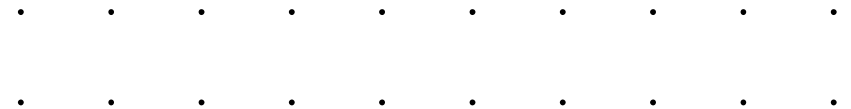

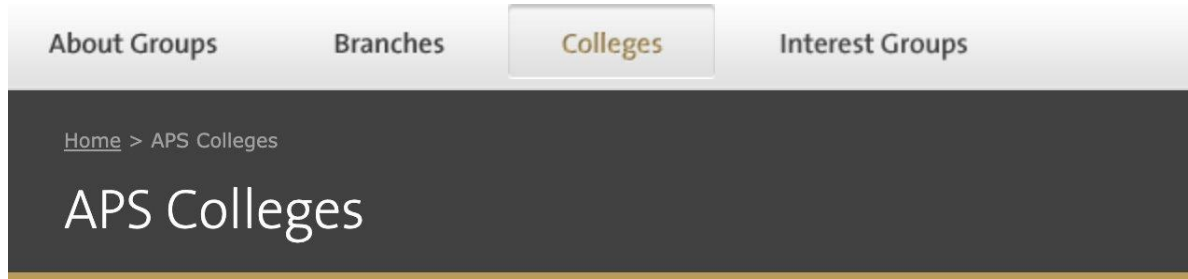
Pathways to registration as a psychologist



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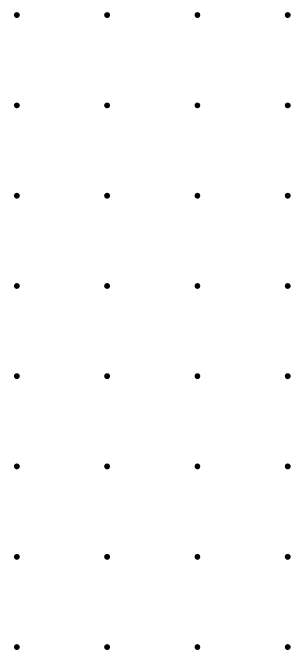
Australian Psychological Society Colleges
