


# BUDGETING FOR STUDY

<b>Living Expenses</b>			
Rent	240	12,480	Private room in a shared house or apartment ranges from \$140 - \$350
Bond		1043	once only payment at the start of the tenancy as a security deposit & is refunded at the end
Establishment Costs		600	e.g. desk, bed, etc.
Gas, Electricity, water Bills	40	2,080	depends on usage
Mobile & Internet	25	1,300	depends on usage
<b>Food</b>	110 - 190	5,000 – 10,000	cheaper if cook at home & pack your own lunches
<b>Spending Money</b>			
Haircuts, sport, entertainment, chemist, household insurance, etc.	40	2,080	approximate only, depends on your needs
<b>Travel</b>			
Weekly fares	22 - 45	877 - 1755 (approx)	Public transport ticketing system -MYKI price varies depending on type of fare – some discounted fares apply including an <a href="#">iUSE</a> pass. For other fare options see <a href="#">PTV</a> (daily tickets are more expensive)
