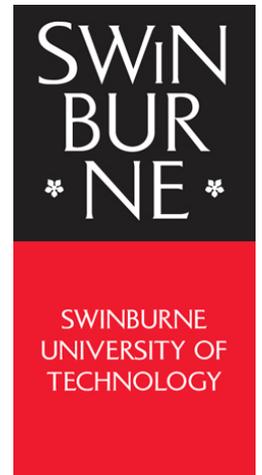

Nethmini: "You can take your time with a question the way you'd want to take it."

Jacqueline: "You don't need to feel like you don't understand something – you can always come here and be helped through any problems that you're having. I would definitely recommend it for any first-year student."

Hassan: "If you have got any problems do not waste your time getting frustrated and losing your confidence, always remember that MASH is the best place for your problem."
