WHAT DOES IT OFFER?

You'll receive 30% off your course fees for the duration of your degree.

If you have achieved a 90% GPA Australian standard equivalent (or above), you'll be considered for our Swinburne International Excellence Postgraduate Scholarship (see below).

WHO CAN APPLY?

You must not hold another scholarship or reduced fee arrangement from Swinburne.

Citizens of any country, except Australia or New Zealand and permanent residents of Australia.

WHEN CAN I START?

You'll start studying online in Semester 2, 2020 or Semester 1 or 2, 2021.

Swinburne International Excellence Pathway Scholarship

WHAT DOES IT OFFER?

You'll receive a fixed amount of A\$2500 per year deducted from your course fees for a maximum of 2 years.

WHICH COURSES ARE INCLUDED?

- Foundation Year + UniLink diploma + bachelor degree
- Foundation Year + bachelor degree
- UniLink diploma + bachelor degree
- PQP + postgraduate degree

WHO CAN APPLY?

You must have achieved an academic result of at least 60% GPA (Australian standard equivalent).

You must not hold another scholarship or reduced fee arrangement from Swinburne.

You must not be currently accepted or enrolled at Swinburne, unless you are only enrolled in our ELICOS program.

Citizens of any country, except Australia or New Zealand and permanent residents of Australia.

You'll start studying online in Semester 2, 2020 or Semester 1 or 2, 2021.

Swinburne International Excellence Undergraduate Scholarship

WHAT DOES IT OFFER?

Depending on your GPA, you'll receive 10–75% off your course fees every year for a maximum of 4 years.

- 10% off for GPA 6–6.99 (60–69%)
- 20% off for GPA 7–7.99 (70–79%)
- 30% off for GPA 8–8.99 (80–89%)
- 50% off for GPA 9–9.49 (90–94%)
- 75% off for GPA 9.5+ (95%+)

(Indicative scale only).

WHICH COURSES ARE INCLUDED?

All bachelor degrees, except the Bachelor of Aviation and Piloting and the Bachelor of Aviation and Piloting/Bachelor of Business double degree.

WHO CAN APPLY?

You must have achieved an academic result of at least 60% GPA (Australian standard equivalent).

You must not hold another scholarship or reduced fee arrangement from Swinburne.

You must not be currently accepted or enrolled at Swinburne, unless you are only enrolled in our ELICOS program.

Citizens of any country, except Australia or New Zealand and permanent residents of Australia.

You'll start studying online in Semester 2, 2020 or Semester 1 or 2, 2021.

Swinburne International Alumni Direct Scholarship

WHAT DOES IT OFFER?

You'll receive up to A\$38,000 for undergraduate degrees (10–25% off your course fees every year for up to 4 years).

A\$21,000 for postgraduate degrees (10–25% off your course fees every year for up to 2 years).

A\$2500 fixed amount for the Master of Science (Network Systems)

WHICH COURSES ARE INCLUDED?

All undergraduate and postgraduate degrees, except the Bachelor of Aviation and Piloting and the Bachelor of Aviation and Piloting/Bachelor of Business double degree.

WHO CAN APPLY?

You must have already completed an undergraduate or postgraduate degree or pathway course at Swinburne.

You must be applying for a degree at our Hawthorn campus in Melbourne. Note: you must apply directly to Swinburne (not via an agent or representative).

You must not hold another scholarship or reduced fee arrangement from Swinburne.

Citizens of any country, except Australia or New Zealand and permanent residents of Australia.

You must not be currently accepted or enrolled in a 2-year master by coursework program at Swinburne.

Citizens of any country, except Australia or New Zealand and permanent residents of Australia.

WHEN CAN I START?

You'll start studying online in Semester 2, 2020 or Semester 1 or 2, 2021.

The Dean's Scholarship for Excellence in Architecture and Urban Design

WHAT DOES IT OFFER?

You'll receive 50% off your fees for the duration of your course.

You'll need to submit a 10–20 page portfolio with your application.

If you are not successful, you'll be considered for our International Excellence Postgraduate Scholarship (see above).
