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and partnering with the University of Queensland.

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the school led the rollout of the first Carbon Literacy training in 2021.

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This was the first delivery in Victoria, Australia.

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Since then, there has been seven Carbon Literacy training sessions.

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We at Swinburne currently have 183 students and staff

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who participated in the training, 112 have been certified as carbon literate,

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and they pledged to save nearly 100 tonnes of carbon.

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Our aim is to extend the Carbon Literacy education brand status

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to the entirety of Swinburne University of Technology in 2025,

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while working towards silver certification

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for the School of Business, Law and Entrepreneurship.

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There is a lot of really positive activity going on in the Carbon Literacy

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training area, and students and staff

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are actively engaging in this important area.
