Content: Impact	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Need for solution stated - STEM applied in a new and unique way (some element of innovation in research) - Scope and scale of social impact communicated - Real-world feasibility outlined (including limitations) 	___/10
Clarity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Key terms explained - Language appropriate for an adult audience - Presentation well-structured, so that viewers can follow and are left with an understanding of the STEM topic and impact 	___/10
Delivery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tone of voice - Energy and flow - Accuracy (lack of mistakes) - Pizazz: Creativity, Originality, Charisma - Video editing: clever cuts to help the viewers focus on key points - images, slides, headshots, etc. - Video quality: audio and visual quality to a standard where the competitor can be clearly heard and/or seen. 	___/15
