About Children's University

Children's University fosters a lifelong learning mindset and supports educational aspirations from a young age, by encouraging and celebrating child-led learning beyond the curriculum and classroom.

Run in partnership with schools, the learning program is aimed at students aged 7-14, with a linked volunteer program for students aged 15-18. As the only university in Victoria offering the Children's University program, we are looking to partner with more schools to bring this exciting program to your school community.

How it works

Students opt into the program and engage in a broad range of fun, self-directed learning opportunities through our partner Learning Destinations. Members are issued a *Passport to Learning* and receive stamps for each activity.

Once they collect a minimum of 30 hours, members are invited to attend a graduation ceremony to celebrate their achievements – just like a university student (see our latest Children's University graduation video!).

Program milestones are linked to consecutive award levels which students can build on over a number of years in the program. We support a nominated school representative who will coordinate the group of Children's University members at your school, similar to that of a lunchtime club commitment.
