What you need to know

- All Midyear courses will be delivered onshore at our Hawthorn campus. Students will be expected to arrive in time for face-to-face classes and orientation. There will be no offshore/remote availability.

Early deadlines

- Students who wish to apply for [academic credit](#) (advanced standing) must submit an application for advanced standing five (5) working days prior to the appropriate regional or course-specific application deadline.
- Students who are under 18 must submit their course application and accept their offer two (2) weeks prior to the appropriate regional or course-specific application and acceptance deadlines.
- Students requiring disability support must submit their course application two (2) weeks prior to the relevant regional or course-specific application deadline.
