

Terms and Conditions - next gen_campus student design competition

- 1. This competition is facilitated by Swinburne University of Technology
- 2. The theme of the design competition is to design artworks that depict the collaborative and innovative focus of Swinburne's next gen_campus transformation to decorate construction fencing of the new Latelab and student hub!

Catergory 1: next gen_design award for most innovative artwork (One available)

Category 2: next gen_experience award for best showcase of life at Swinburne (Two available)

Category 3: next gen_collaboration award for best team entries (Two available)

Category 4: next gen_artist award for all other artwork chosen to be displayed but not selected in the above categories

Entries can be any medium and as creative as you like, as long as they do not offend or vilify anyone – inclusivity and community is key! Create your work individually or with a group of mates.

- 3. The competition will close at 17:00 AEST on 12 April 2024. Entries received after of this time will not be considered.
- 4. Entrants must agree with the Terms and Conditions at the time of entry.
- 5. Entry is open to all current Swinburne University students. Entrants aged under 18 years must seek parental/carer permission before submitting their entry. By entering, it is assumed parental/carer permission has been sought and the parent/carer agrees with the Terms and Conditions outlined in this document.
- 6. The entrant affirms that the submission (and any part thereof) is their own work and they own the copyright to their artwork.
- 7. Winners will be named between four categories following the competition. Prizes for these winners include:

Category 1: Apple MacBook 13.6" (one available)

Category 2: Apple AirPods (3rd generation) (two available)

Category 3: VISA gift cards shared between group members to a total shared value of \$1000AUD

Category 4: next gen_campus gift pack including \$100 VISA gift card, tote bag, memobottle, powerbank and other items as determined by Swinburne University of Technology.

- 8. Designs accepted in any medium if they can be photographed and printed. Preferred file type is PDF or PNG. For non-digital mediums, please photograph and send as JPG or PNG. Please note the artwork may need to be made available for reshooting depending on quality of image supplied.
- 9. Entrants must provide the following with their entry:
 - Full name
 - Swinburne Student ID number
 - Phone number
 - Design file
- 11. A panel of judges has been selected to decide the winners. The panel includes Deputy Vice-Chancellor Education, Experience and Employability Professor Laura-Anne Bull, School of Design and Architecture Dean Professor Blair Kuys, and Facilities and Campus Services Director Peter Waite.
- 12. The judges' decision is final.
- 13. Swinburne reserves the right to remove any entry that does not comply with the Terms and Conditions in any way or any entry that is deemed offensive, derogatory or racist.
- 14. The winner/s will be contacted by email and publicly announced via social media channels by 30 April 2024.
- 15. Winning designs will be displayed on construction hoarding until the completion of the new Latelab and student hub, expected to be completed by early 2025.
