Important Information about Changes to Your Course

The Master of Information Technology Project Management suite, including the Graduate Certificate and Graduate Diploma, changed to the Master of Business Information Systems from Study Period 1, 2017. The Master of Business Information Systems suite, including the Graduate Certificate and Graduate Diploma, was discontinued from Study Period 1, 2019.

To qualify for the award of Graduate Certificate of Information Technology Project Management students must complete 8 units of study (100 credit points) as follows:

- 8 Core units

To qualify for the award of Graduate Diploma of Information Technology Project Management students must complete 12 units of study (150 credit points) as follows:

- 4 Core Introductory IS units;
- 7 Core ITPM units; and
- 1 elective from the approved list of electives

To qualify for the award of Master of Information Technology Project Management students must complete 16 units of study (200 credit points) as follows:

- 4 Core Introductory IS units; and
- 10 Core ITPM units; and
- 2 electives from the approved list of electives

Students with a previous tertiary degree in IS or IT from a recognised institution and/or relevant work experience may be eligible for exemptions.

Regardless of any credit awarded within this degree, students must complete a minimum of 50% of the units with Swinburne University as part of this degree Suite.
