

# STUDY ABROAD AT SWINBURNE

## Summer and Winter Terms

**Spend six weeks studying at Swinburne University of Technology in Melbourne, Australia, during a Summer or Winter term. Courses are taught in intensive mode, allowing you to accelerate your degree during your semester break – and possibly graduate sooner!**

Swinburne is a world-class, multidisciplinary institution leading the way in science, technology, business, design and innovation. Swinburne is ranked 45 in the world in the 'Top 50 Under 50' QS World University Rankings.

Study Abroad is a unique opportunity to travel and experience life in Melbourne, named the world's most liveable city for the seventh year running by The Economist Intelligence Unit's Global Liveability Index. You get to live as the locals do, expand your horizons and make treasured life-long memories while continuing your academic progress.

## Entry Requirements

Successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary institution is required to Study Abroad with Swinburne.

Students may also be required to provide evidence of English language proficiency. This may include one of:

- IELTS: 6.0 overall (no band score below 5.5)
- Internet-based TOEFL: 75 (no band score below 17).

Applicants from non-English speaking backgrounds may complete a preparatory English language course before commencing their Study Abroad program. Fees apply and vary depending on the length of the program.

Applicants from English-speaking countries may provide secondary school English results as evidence of English language proficiency. Applicants from universities in the USA must have a GPA of 2.6 or higher.

## Fees

Students undertaking a Summer or Winter term at Swinburne can choose to complete one or two units of study. Fees include tuition costs, airport pick-up and orientation.
