

Summer and Winter Terms

Spend six weeks studying at Swinburne University of Technology in Melbourne, Australia, during a Summer or Winter term. Courses are taught in intensive mode, allowing you to accelerate your degree during your semester break – and possibly graduate sooner!

You get to live as the locals do, expand your horizons and make treasured life-long memories while continuing your academic progress.

Entry Requirements

Successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary institution is required to Study Abroad with Swinburne.

Students may also be required to provide evidence of English language proficiency. This may include one of:

- IELTS: 6.0 overall (no band score below 5.5)
- Internet-based TOEFL: 75 (no band score below 17).

Applicants from non-English speaking backgrounds may complete a preparatory English language course before commencing their Study Abroad program. Fees apply and vary depending on the length of the program.

Applicants from English-speaking countries may provide secondary school English results as evidence of English language proficiency. Applicants from universities in the USA must have a GPA of 2.6 or higher.

Fees

Students undertaking a Summer or Winter term at Swinburne can choose to complete one or two units of study. Fees include tuition costs, airport pick-up and orientation.
