Program Purpose

- Be available for the Study Overseas Pop up Expo (TBC)
- Participate in the Student Panel at the Pre-Departure Session
- Other tasks to assist the Study Abroad office

Eligibility

- Completed a semester exchange within the last 12 months

- Have been selected through a competitive process (short written response and interview)

Application

Students must nominate themselves by submitting a copy of their CV and a half-page letter of motivation outlining why they would be an ideal candidate.

Shortlisted students will then have a short interview with Swinburne Abroad and offered a place.
