# **Certificate II in Landscaping**



Course code: AHC21616

The Certificate II in Landscaping provides an occupational outcome in landscaping. The landscaping industry expects this qualification to be achieved to meet job outcomes at this level. The essential units are designed to develop students' workplace skills that are highly valued by employers. These include workplace health and safety, basic landscaping techniques, machinery operation and the use of powered and non-powered hand tools.

On successful completion of a VETiS course, students are guaranteed a place in a Swinburne Vocational Education program (subject to entry requirements for the course they wish to undertake are met).

Two years part-time

- Qualification: AHC21616 Certificate II in Landscaping

## **Structured Workplace Learning**
