


Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App is installed as part of the Windows 10 SOE


Click on the **Start** menu in the taskbar then on the **Adobe Creative Cloud Application** to launch it

Center and install it




Enter your **Swinburne email** address in the space provided




If you have previously setup an Adobe ID, you may be prompted to select the type of account to sign in with. Select **Enterprise ID**

Adobe will recognise that your Enterprise Adobe ID is associated with Swinburne and redirect you to the Office 365 portal to sign in




Enter your **Swinburne email address** and click on the **Next** button




Enter your **password** and click on the **Sign In** button



Select either **Yes** or **No** to stay signed in to Office 365




Your Swinburne Office 365 account is now logging into your Adobe account

update to the latest version


This is a one time only process!

Click the **Sign In** button to sign back in






Once signed into the **Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App**,

app available to download




Navigate to the application you with to download and click on the **Install** button
