

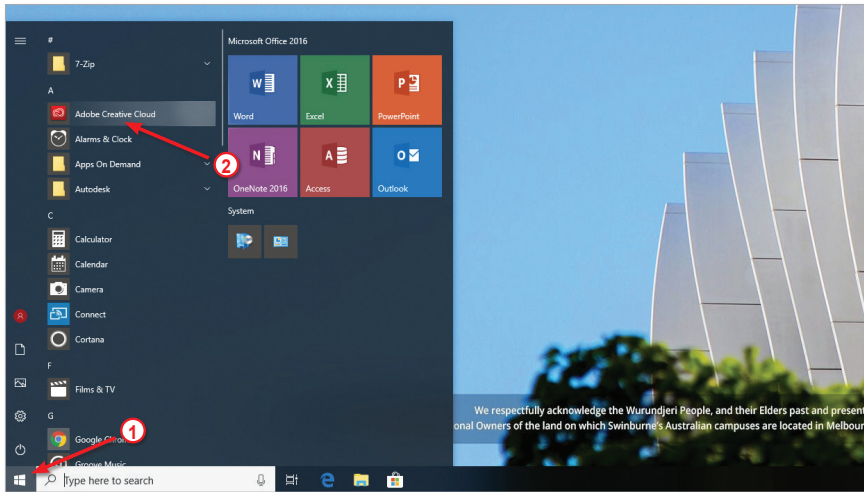


Adobe CC Desktop Application Staff User Guide

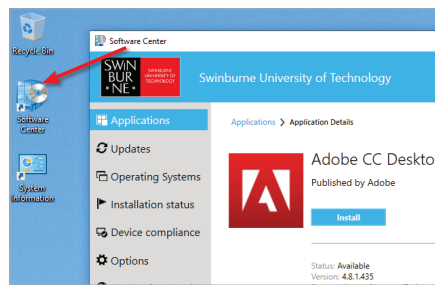
The purpose of this guide is to assist staff in using the Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop Application in order to download Adobe CC applications with their Swinburne provided Adobe ID

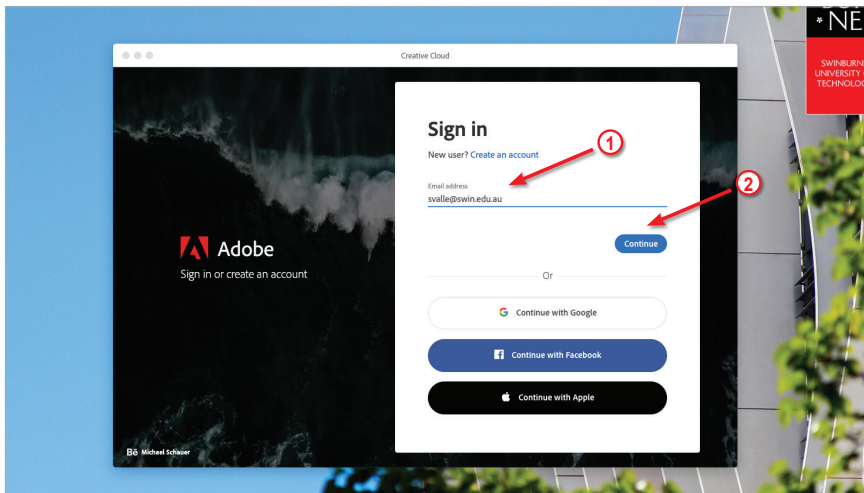
Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App is installed as part of the Windows 10 SOE

Click on the **Start** menu in the taskbar then on the **Adobe Creative Cloud Application** to launch it



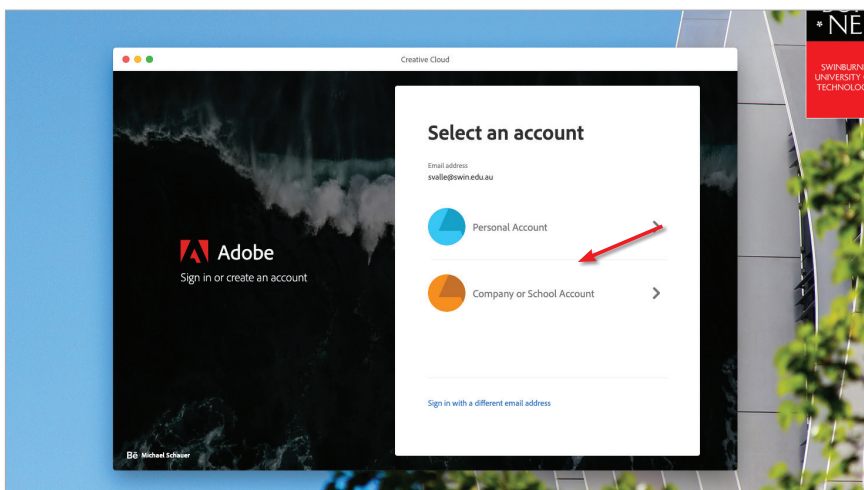
If the **Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App** is not installed on your PC, please open Software Center and install it

Enter your **Swinburne email address** in the space provided and click the **Continue** button

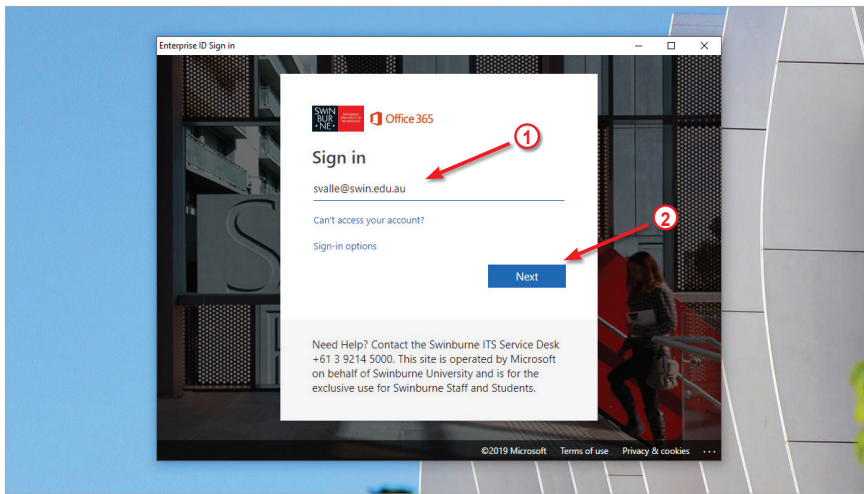

If you have previously setup an Adobe ID, you may be prompted to select the type of account to sign in with. Select **Company or School Account**

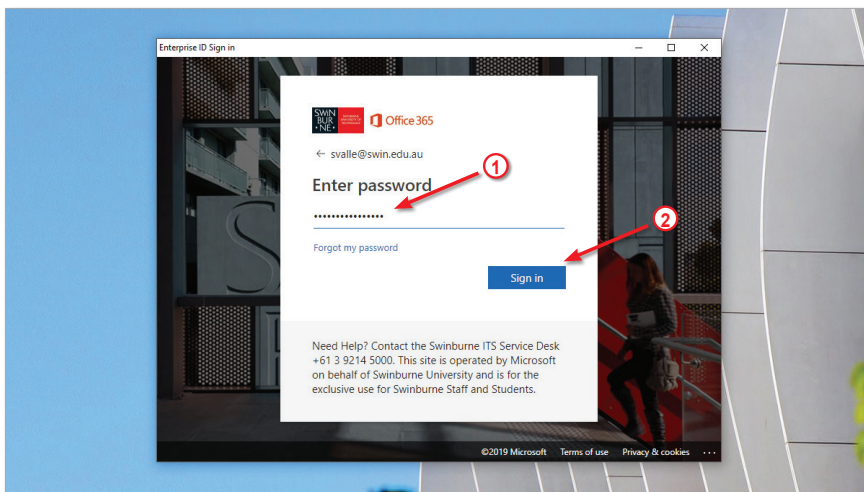
Adobe will recognise that your email address is associated with a Swinburne provided Adobe ID and redirect you to the Office 365 portal to sign in

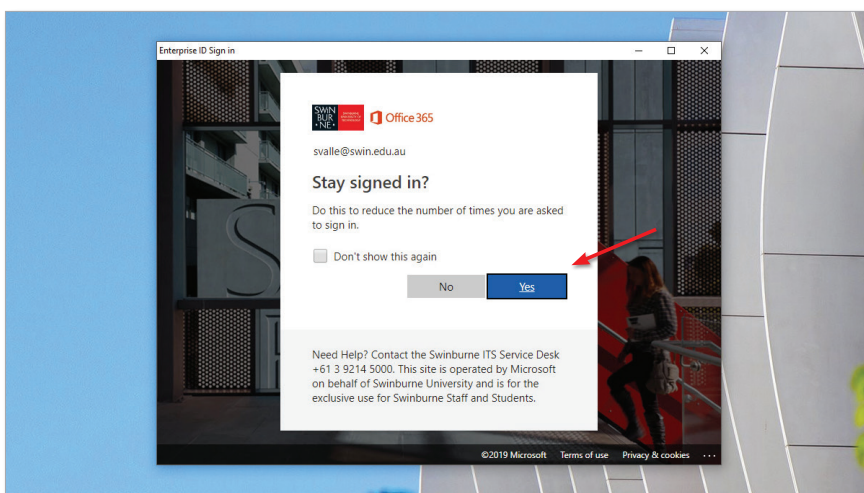


Enter your **Swinburne email address** and click on the **Next** button

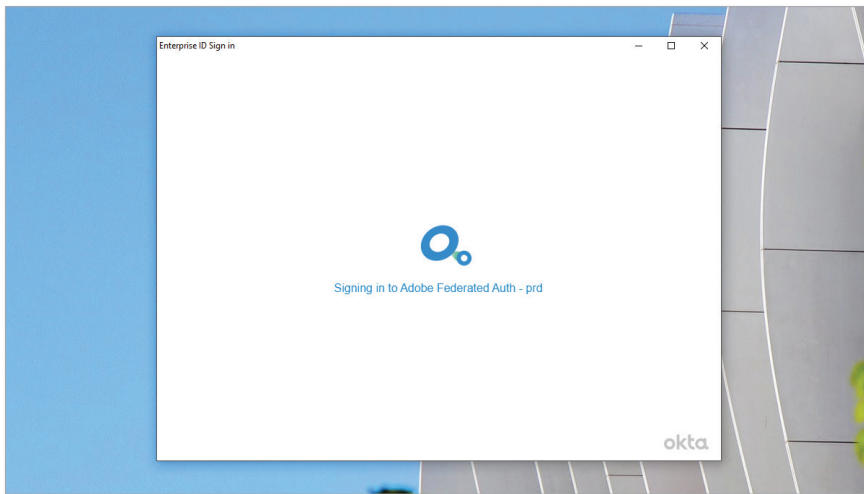

Enter your **password** and click on the **Sign In** button

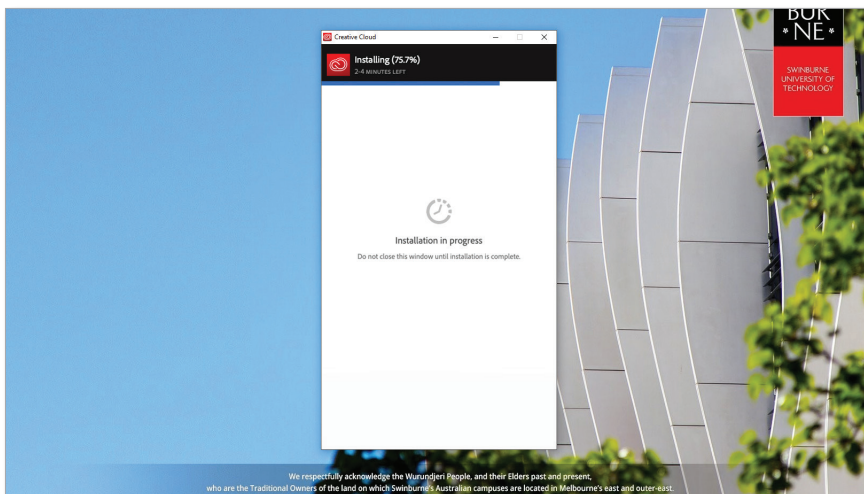


Select **Yes** to stay signed in to Office 365

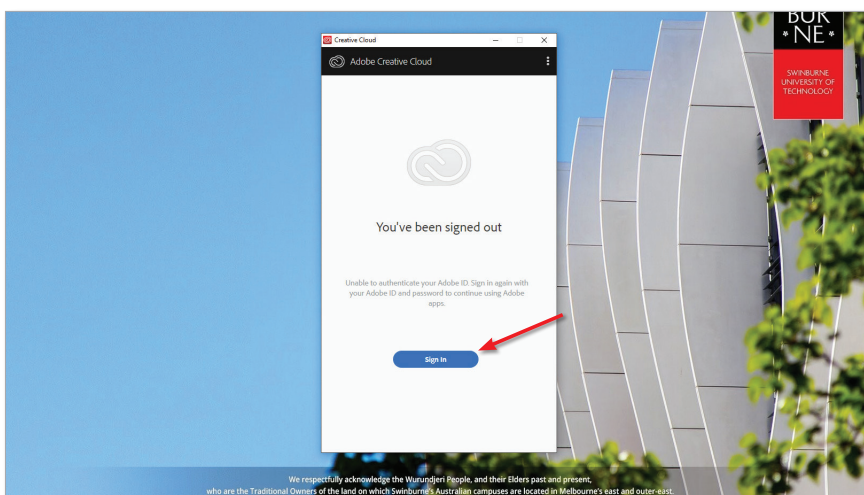


Your Swinburne Office 365 account is now logging into your Adobe account

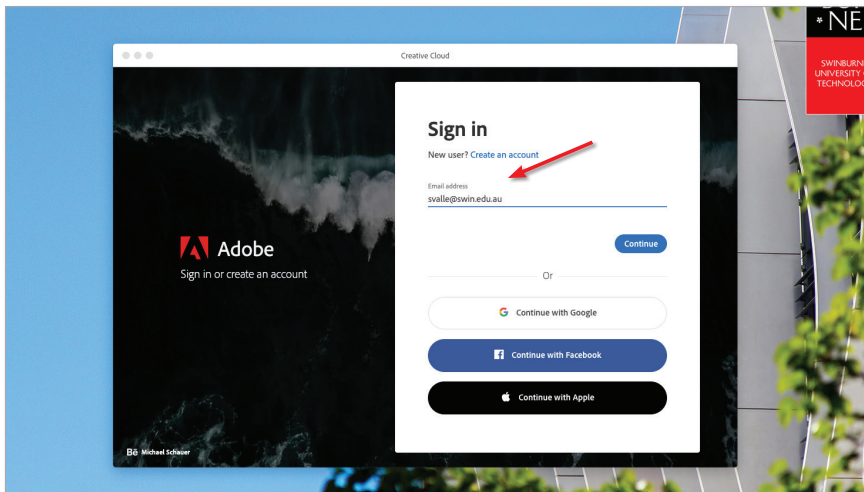
If required, the **Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App** will proceed to update to the latest version

Click the **Sign In** button to sign back in

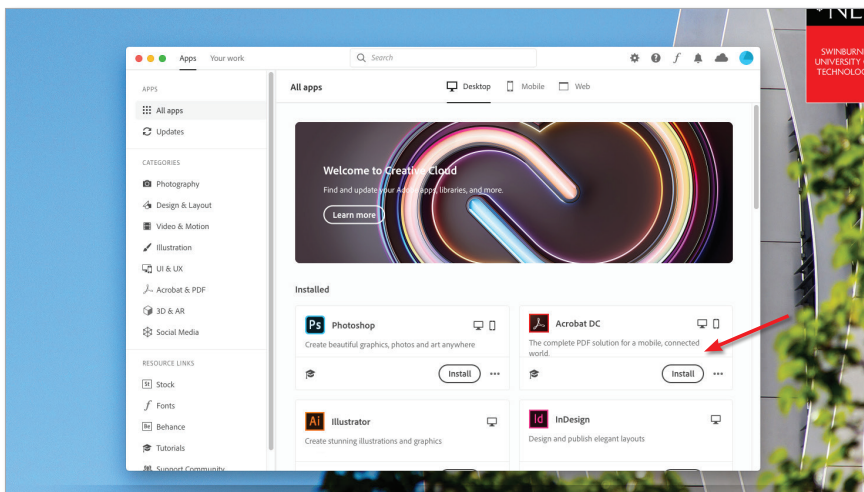

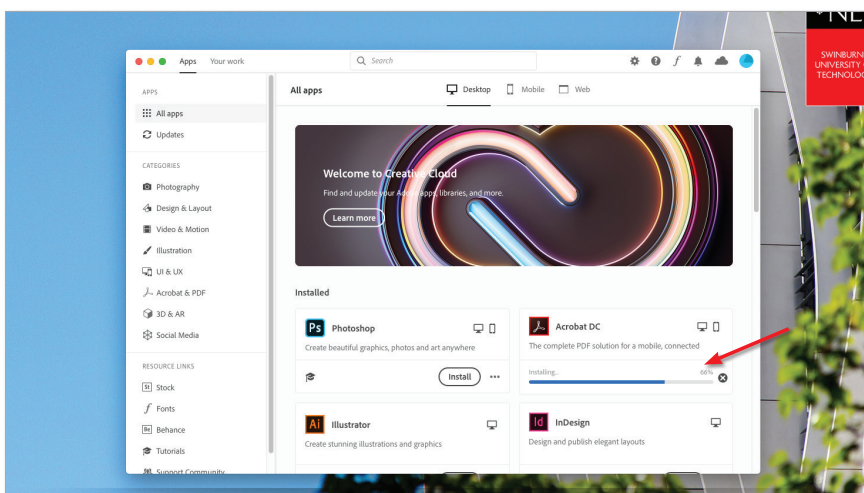
Enter your **Swinburne email address** in the space provided

You will be redirected to Office 365, however as you have previously signed in, you should not be asked to provide credentials

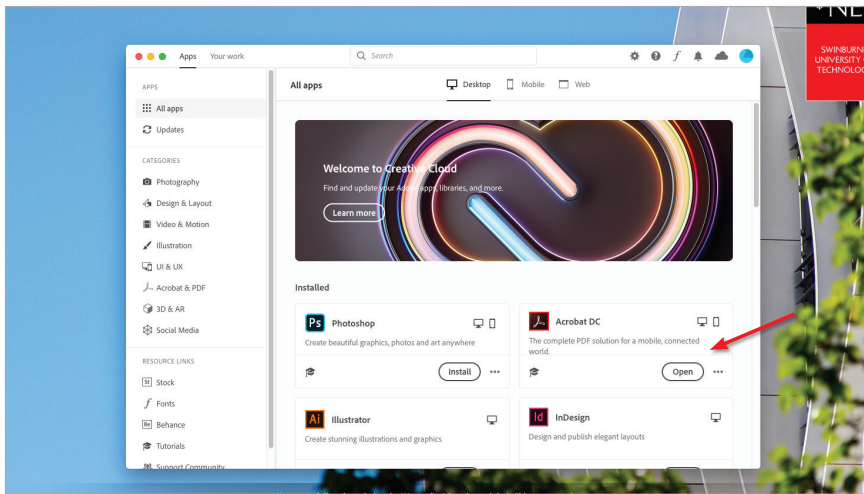

Once signed into the **Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App**, the list of apps available to install will be presented to you. Select any Adobe application and click on the **Install** button

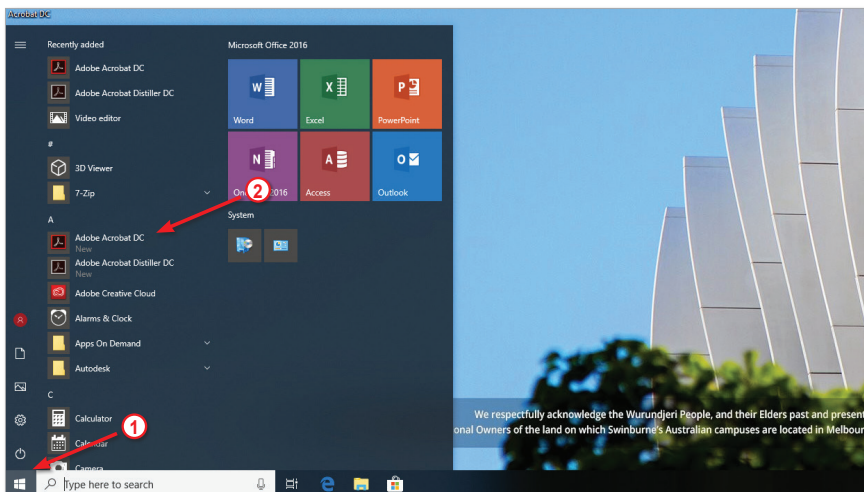


The application you have chosen will begin to download and install
