


Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop

Windows 10 SOE


Click on the **Start** menu in the taskbar then on the **Adobe Creative Cloud Application** to launch it

Center and install it




Enter your **Swinburne email address** in the space provided and click the **Continue** button




If you have previously setup an Adobe ID, you may be prompted to select the type of account to sign in with. Select **Company or School Account**


Adobe will recognise that your email address is associated with a Swinburne provided Adobe ID and redirect you to the Office 365 portal to sign in




Enter your **Swinburne email address** and click on the **Next**button




Enter your **password** and click on the **Sign In** button




Select **Yes** to stay signed in to Office 365



Your Swinburne Office 365 account is now logging into your Adobe account




If required, the **Adobe Creative** Cloud Desktop App will proceed to update to the latest version




Upon completion, the **Adobe** Creative Cloud Desktop App will sign you out

Click the **Sign In** button to sign back in




Enter your **Swinburne email address** in the space provided


You will be redirected to Office 365, however as you have previously signed in, you should not be asked to provide credentials




Once signed into the **Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App**, the list of apps available to install will be presented to you. Select any Adobe application and click on the **Install** button
